Revised Skilled Nursing Facility Visitation

Effective 6/28/2021

Visitation Schedule:

- **Visitation hours are daily from 9am – 11:00am and 3pm – 5pm.**

- Visitors are required to make an appointment with Ms. Bernadette Seward Tel: (516) 694-9800 x 236 from the hours of 9 am – 12 pm Monday through Friday. Appointments have to be made **at least** one day prior to visiting.
- No more than 2 visitors are allowed per resident. Individuals under the age of 16 are to be accompanied by an adult.
- Temperature will be taken by a staff member and a Visitor Screening Questionnaire has to be filled out upon arrival at the facility.
- Visitors will be escorted to visitation location
- Visitors are to adhere to the core principles of Covid-19 infection – wearing a face mask covering nose and mouth at all times when on the facility's premises, maintaining social distance (at least 6 feet apart) to other residents, hand hygiene, etc. .
- A fully vaccinated resident may choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor while wearing a well-fitted face mask and performing hand hygiene before and after
- If the resident is unvaccinated, social distancing (at least 6 feet apart) has to be adhered to – no physical contact;
- However, visitors should physically distance from other residents and staff in the facility
- The facility will have adequate supply of masks on hand for visitors and make available to visitors who lack an acceptable face covering.
- At no time are visitors allowed to remove their loved ones from the designated visiting areas. Staff will be on site to address any kind of issues.

Compassionate Care Visits will follow the same visiting hours and will be scheduled by the Director of Recreation, Ms. Patricia Thomson-Kinane, Tel: (516) 694-9800 x 230. Visitors will be provided with appropriate Personal protective equipment (PPE) and are to stay in the resident's room for the duration of the visit. Before exiting the room, PPE has to be removed and discarded in the room. Staff will be available for guidance.

The safety and well being of our residents is our top priority.

If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.
